Question: Who is eligible to be a mentor?

Answer: In the past, we have recruited elderly individuals still living in their home or an apartment who could use some extra help in order to keep up with home responsibilities and who are still mentally capable of making new relationships will serve as mentors. We are intentionally broadening the definition to include individuals who are passionate about mentoring young people, whether they be 40 or 90 years old. An Assist or PFE program mentor is someone who intentionally helps their mentee develop life skills, flesh out life values, and strengthen positive relationships with peers and the community around them.
